New Federal Data Security Measures Start December 9 - Is your Company Ready?

Debt buyers, third-party debt collectors, and others have until December 9 to come into compliance with recent regulatory amendments to the Safeguards Rule adopted by the Federal Trade Commission. The Rule was first promulgated in 2002 under authority granted to the FTC by the Gramm-Leach-Bliley Act in 1999, which regulates privacy and data security practices of financial institutions which cover debt collectors and debt buyers as well as originating creditors. The changes become effective on December 9 and impact companies large and small as well as the vendors who serve them.

Three data privacy professionals discuss the changes made by the amendments and the steps you need to take now to bring your company into compliance by December 9.
